THAT the Corporation of the Town of Greenfield Park does hereby accept the offer of the Director, the Veterans' Land Act, of the sum of EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORTY SEVEN CENTS (\$878.47) for the purchase of Lot bearing Cad. No. 241-34-3 of the Official Plan and Book of Reference of the Parish of St. Antoine de Longueuil;

THAT the said Director will be responsible for all legal, notarial and/or survey fees affecting such Lot;

THAT the said Director will be responsible for the cost of all future local improvements affecting such Lot;

THAT the said Director will submit plans in triplicate to the Council of the building he intends to build on said Lot;

THAT the Mayor, Mr. L. J. Galletti and the Secretary-Treasurer, Mr. J. H. Pagé, are hereby authorized to represent and act on behalf of the Town of Greenfield Park to give effect to the present Resolution.

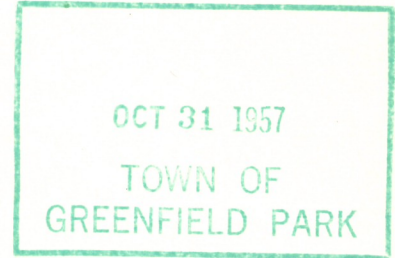


Dear Sir:-
