nary place and hour of the sittings of said Council, on Wed-
nesday, the seventh day of the month of May one thousand
eight hundred and ninety four, at two o'clock of the after-
noon, in conformity with the provisions of the Municipal
Code of the Province of Quebec and amendments.

Present - Pierre Basil Lacombe Esq. Mayor
and the Councillors Pierre Lacombe, Jean B. Desrochers
Joseph Charbon and Arthur Desjardins, forming a
quorum of said Council, presided over by the
Mayor -

the secretary having being also Present
The said Council with hearty opinion and make
the following By-law, to wit -

By-law No. 1 -

By-law of the Municipal Council of the parish
of St Antoine de Sanguin preventing persons from
bathing or washing themselves in the St Lawrence river
in the open air, close to the public roads or squares
in the limits of said Municipality -

Article first -

Whosoever will bath or wash himself, in the St
Lawrence river, in the open air, close to the public
roads or squares or at a distance of less than
ten feet from all such public roads or squares,
in the limits of said Municipality will incur
a penalty of not less than one dollar and not
exceeding ten dollars and costs and in default of

the payment of said Penalty and Costs, upon
Conviction, will be Condensed possible to an im-
Prisonment in the Common Jail of said District
for a term not exceeding thirty days -
article 2^d.

Any Constable or Police Officer of said
Municipality Can and must apprehend or
arrest at sight, all persons found Contravening
the provisions of the present by-law and bring
them before any Justice of the Peace to be dealt
with according to law and the present by-
law.

article third.

The present by-law shall Come in force
and effect after eight days after its pro-
mulgation.
